STUDENT UNIFORM POLICY

BPA is a mandatory uniform school. Uniforms must be worn daily by all students. Our uniform policy and dress code guidelines indicate appropriate school attire for normal school days. Students are expected to follow these guidelines with support from their parents/guardians. School Spirit Shirts will be on sale in the Main Office throughout the school year. Please purchase at least one Spirit Shirt since student will be required to wear for in-county Field Trips. Students can also wear their Spirit Shirts on designated "Spirit Shirt Days."

<h3>MASKS</h3>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students may opt-out of wearing masks, per parent, once a form has been completed & submitted to main office.

ALL STUDENTS:

1. Students may **NOT** wear cargo pants with pockets. Bottoms may not be jean material and must fit the student appropriately. NO joggers, sweatpants or leggings will be permitted.
2. Shorts must be an appropriate length and fit the student correctly.
3. ONLY school sweaters and hoodies are allowed.
4. Shoes must be closed toe and appropriate for P.E. classes.
5. Good grooming of hair, skin, and fingernails is expected daily.
6. NO headgear (hats, scarves, and bandanas) will be permitted.

Any student not wearing complete uniform or in violation of any of the above mentioned infractions will be issued a warning. A referral will be issued for continued violations of the uniform policy. Referrals are entered in district database. Continued violations of our uniform policy will be addressed in a meeting with Administration and will be stated in student's records.
